

## WORKPLAN FOR VISITING PROFESSOR

The individual workplan presented by the candidate must be written in Portuguese or Spanish and should meet all the following expected requirements:

- Undergraduate course on "Art History", offered in the Undergraduate Program in History, during the second term (semester) of 2019 and the first term (semester) of 2020.
- 2. Elective undergraduate courses in the Undergraduate Program in History, during the whole period of activities as Visiting Professor.
- 3. Elective graduate courses in the Graduate Program in History, on topics pertaining to the "Social History of Culture" Research Field.
- In each term (corresponding to a semester), the selected candidate must offer a total of 120 hours of courses, including undergraduate and graduate courses. Courses are usually offered in a 60-hour format or, exceptionally, a 30-hour format.
- 5. Development of research activities on topics pertaining to the "Social History of Culture" Research Field, during the whole period of activities as Visiting Professor, in accordance with a brief research project, no longer than 2 pages, presented in the individual workplan.
- 6. Organization of academic event (e.g. seminar/conference) on topics pertaining to the "Social History of Culture" Research Field.
- Participation in examination boards for undergraduate dissertations, master's dissertations, and doctoral theses.
- 8. Planning and execution of university outreach activities.
- Preparation and/or publishing of at least one the following outputs on each year: paper in a scientific peer-reviewed journal, book chapter, or book.
- 10. The individual workplan presented by the candidate must include a personal presentation text, no longer than 10 pages, presenting the candidate's academic



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background and stressing the relevance of his or her scientific production to the fields related to the Visiting Professorship.
